

BY-LAW #14

A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PERTH-ANDOVER
RESPECTING A CURFEW

The Council of the Municipality of Perth-Andover under the authority vested in it by Section 96 of the Municipalities Act (1966) duly assembled hereby enacts as follows, on this the 5th day of March, A.D. 1973.

1. In this By-Law:

- (a) "adult" means a person who has attained the age of nineteen years;
- (b) "child" means a boy or girl actually or apparently under sixteen years of age; and
- (c) "public place" includes a street, highway, or lane whether a thoroughfare or not, a place of public resort and a place to which the public has access.

2. No child be in a public place in the municipality after ten o'clock in the evening unless he is accompanied by an adult.

3. A peace officer may order a child found in a public place contrary to section 2 to go home and where that child neglects or refuses to do so, the peace officer may take him to a children's shelter.

4. A parent, guardian or other person who has in law or in fact the custody or control of a child and who permits that child to violate section 2 is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to fine not exceeding \$5.00 for the first offence and not exceeding \$10.00 for a subsequent offence.

5. For the purposes of this By-Law, a police station in the municipality is a children's shelter.

CURFEW

6. This By-Law comes into force on the date of final passing thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME this 12th day of February 1973.

READ A SECOND TIME this 12th day of February 1973.

READ A THIRD TIME this 5th day of March 1973.
